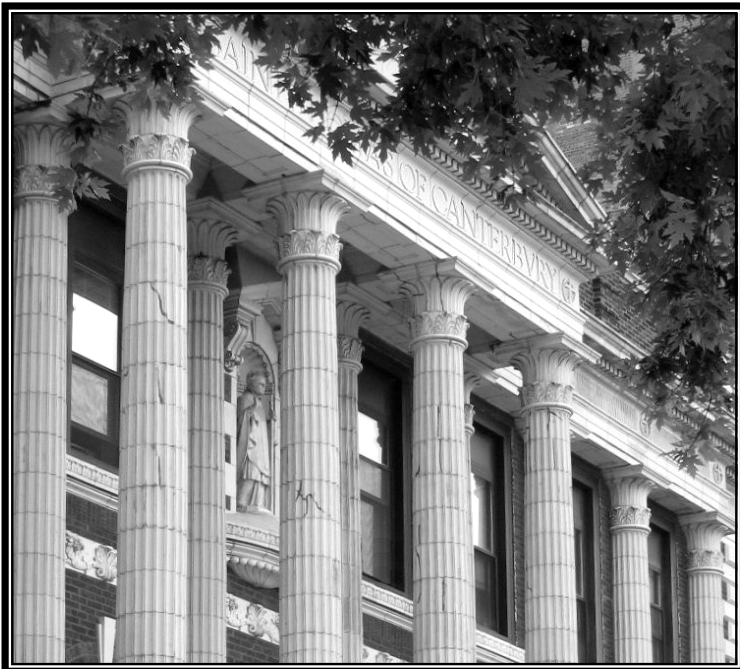

This weekend, we welcome our new bishop to Saint Thomas of Canterbury for the first time. Ordained just a few weeks ago, Bishop Mark Bartosic has been assigned to Vicariate II (the part of the archdiocese in which we are located) and replaces retired Bishop Francis Kane.

Bishop Bartosic was born in Wisconsin but raised in Ohio in a large Catholic family. He moved to Chicago in 1983 to pursue a career in acting. He immediately fell in love with the city, the Archdiocese and its people. After a while, he decided to abandon acting to enter the seminary. Ordained in 1994 (with the new Bishops Bob Casey and Ron Hicks as his seminary classmates), he has ministered in Latino communities for his entire priesthood. His assignments have included associate pastor, St. Agnes of Bohemia (1994-2000); pastor, St. Frances of Rome, Cicero (2001-2016) and Our Lady of Charity, Cicero (2009-2016); pastor, Assumption BVM (California Avenue) and director, Kolbe House Jail Ministry (2016-2018).

We are delighted to have him as our bishop and look forward to his presence among us this weekend.

Este fin de semana, le damos la bienvenida a nuestro nuevo obispo a Saint Thomas of Canterbury por primera vez. Ordenado hace apenas unas semanas, el obispo Mark Bartosic fue asignado al Vicariato II (la parte de la archidiócesis en la que estamos ubicados) y reemplaza al obispo retirado Francis Kane.

El obispo Bartosic nació en Wisconsin pero se crió en Ohio en una gran familia católica. Se mudó a Chicago en 1983 para seguir una carrera en la actuación. Inmediatamente se enamoró de la ciudad, la Arquidiócesis y su gente. Después de un tiempo, decidió abandonar la actuación para ingresar al seminario. Ordenado en 1994 (con los nuevos Obispos Bob Casey y Ron Hicks como sus compañeros de clase en el seminario), ha hecho su ministerio en las comunidades latinas durante todo su sacerdocio. Sus tareas han incluido el pastor asociado, Santa Inés de Bohemia (1994-2000); pastor, Santa Francisca de Roma, Ciceró (2001-2016) y Nuestra Señora de la Caridad, Ciceró (2009-2016); pastor, Asunción BVM (California Avenue) y director, Ministerio de la cárcel de la Casa Kolbe (2016-2018).

Estamos encantados de tenerlo como nuestro obispo y esperamos su presencia entre nosotros este fin de semana.
